SUBJECTS

EVENTS

Short Introductions (SI)

Seminar (SEM)

More interactive, with the opportunity and expectation of interaction by participants other than the main one or few leaders/presenters. Ample time for Q/A and open critical discussion. A traditional seminar as one would expect in a post-graduate curriculum or at a conference.

Duration: from 1 to 3 hours. See also notes on Courses.

Mini-seminar (MSem)

Simply shorter in duration and with generally only 1 or 2 leader/presenters from TETRADYN

Duration: generally no more than 1 hour.

Tutorial (TUT)

Focused, structured mini-course on specific practices and techniques. Very much “how to” on methods, processes, techniques that may involve instrumentation, software, or human/mechanical procedures.

Generally there will be some form of “exam” to recap and to measure what knowledge has been gained.

Duration: generally 2 to 4 hours but possibly a full day event.

Workshop (WK)
